LETTER FROM THE BOARD

(1) PROPOSED GRANT OF GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE AND REPURCHASE SHARES

The existing general mandate granted to the Directors to allot and issue new Shares and to repurchase Shares at the annual general meeting of the Company held on 19 September 2025 will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM.

At the AGM, ordinary resolutions will be proposed to the Shareholders (a) approving the grant of the General Mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and otherwise deal in the Shares (including any sale or transfer of treasury shares) not exceeding 20% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) as at the date of passing such resolution; (b) approving the grant of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors to repurchase, inter alia, Shares on GEM of the Stock Exchange, the number of which does not exceed 10% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) as at the date of passing such resolution; and (c) adding to the total number of Shares which may be allotted, issued or dealt in under the General Mandate the number of Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate.

The General Mandate

Under the General Mandate, the Directors will be given an unconditional general mandate to allot, issue and otherwise deal in the Shares (including any sale or transfer of treasury shares) representing not more than 20% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) as at the date of passing such resolution.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Company had an aggregate of 1,352,759,971 Shares in issue. Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution for the approval of the General Mandate and assuming that no Shares will be issued or repurchased by the Company between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the General Mandate to allot, issue and deal with up to a maximum of 270,551,994 new Shares.

The Repurchase Mandate

At the AGM, it is also proposed that the Repurchase Mandate be granted to the Directors.

Under the Repurchase Mandate, the Directors will be given an unconditional general mandate to repurchase Shares representing not more than 10% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares) as at the date of passing such resolution, on GEM.

A retiring Director shall be eligible for re-election.

In accordance with Article 87(1) of the Articles of Association, Mr. Wu Qiyou (“**Mr. Wu**”) and Mr. Lau Tak Kei, Arthur (“**Mr. Lau**”) shall retire from their offices at the AGM and, being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election.

At the AGM, ordinary resolutions will be proposed to re-elect each of Mr. Wu and Mr. Lau as an executive/independent non-executive Director (as the case may be).

Details of the Directors who are proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

The Nomination Committee has reviewed the structure and composition of the Board, the gender, age, cultural and educational background, ethnicity, professional experience, skills, knowledge and length of service of the retiring Directors with reference to the nomination principles and the independence of the independent non-executive Directors. The Nomination Committee has recommended to the Board on re-election of all the retiring Directors at the AGM. The Board considers that Mr. Wu and Mr. Lau are able to continue to fulfil their duties as required and Mr. Lau has confirmed that (i) he met the independence criteria as set out in Rule 5.09(1) to (8) of the GEM Listing Rules; (ii) he has no past or present financial or other interest in the business of the Company or its subsidiaries or any connection with any core connected person (as defined under the GEM Listing Rules) of the Company; and (iii) there are no other factors that may affect his independence at the time of his appointment. Accordingly, with the recommendation of the Nomination Committee, the Board has proposed that each of Mr. Wu and Mr. Lau be re-elected by the Shareholders at the AGM.

(3) PROPOSED RE-APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR

The Board (which agreed with the view of the Audit Committee) recommended that, subject to the approval of the Shareholders at the AGM, HLB Hodgson Impey Cheng Limited be reappointed as the auditors of the Company for the financial year ending 31 March 2027.

The estimated audit fee payable to HLB Hodgson Impey Cheng Limited for the audit of the consolidated financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the financial year ending 31 March 2027 is expected to be approximately HK\$0.60 million to HK\$0.65 million (exclusive of out-of-pocket expenses). Such fee has been determined after due consideration and arm's length negotiations between the Company and HLB Hodgson Impey Cheng Limited, taking into account, among other things, historical audit fees, prevailing market rates, the complexity and business plans of the Group, the expected scope of the audit, the audit timetable, and the auditor's resources required. The estimated audit fee has been determined on the basis that no material changes are expected in the Group's operations, accounting policies or regulatory environment during the financial year, and that the Company will provide timely and adequate assistance and information as reasonably required for the audit.

This is an explanatory statement given to all Shareholders relating to the resolution to be proposed at the AGM authorising the Repurchase Mandate. It contains all the relevant information required pursuant to Rule 13.08 of the GEM Listing Rules which is set out as follows:

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 1,352,759,971 Shares of HK\$0.05 each and 19,700,000 convertible preference shares of HK\$0.05 each and the Company did not have any treasury shares.

Subject to the passing of the resolution in relation to the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the AGM, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 135,275,997 Shares, representing approximately 10% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares).

2. EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate, on the basis of 1,352,759,971 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date, would result in 135,275,997 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the period from the date of the passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate and up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company after the AGM; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company after the AGM is required by the Articles of Association or the Companies Act or any other applicable laws of the Cayman Islands to be held; or (iii) the revocation, variation or renewal of the Repurchase Mandate by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in a general meeting, whichever occurs first.

3. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

7. UNDERTAKING OF THE DIRECTORS

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules and the applicable laws of Hong Kong and in accordance with the regulations set out in the memorandum of association of the Company, the Articles of Association and also any applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

From 2016 to 2020, Mr. Wu served as an investment manager at Cornerstone Capital Investment Group Pty Ltd, leading multiple commercial real estate projects involving retirement and medical assets, monitoring compliance and conducting risk control for those projects. From 2021 to 2022, Mr. Wu was a member of the management team at Lunghealth Medtech Company Limited, spearheading the strategic rollout of the magnetic navigation bronchoscope system in the Chinese market, ensuring the safety of the product and overseeing the compliance with the relevant laws and regulations. In December 2022, Mr. Wu founded Dynamiq Advisory Pte Ltd (“Dynamiq Advisory”) and has been the chief executive officer Dynamiq Advisory thereafter, providing its clients with comprehensive corporate services, including but not limited to compliance and risk management services.

Mr. Wu has entered into a service agreement with the Company for a term of three years renewable automatically upon expiry of the term, unless terminated by a three (3)-month prior written notice by either party after the expiry of the term. Mr. Wu is subject to retirement by rotation and reelection at the first annual general meeting of the Company after his appointment pursuant to the Articles of Association and thereafter subject to retirement by rotation and reelection at annual general meeting of the Company at least once every three years according to the provisions of the Articles, the GEM Listing Rules and other applicable laws. Mr. Wu is entitled to a monthly director’s fee of HK\$20,000 and a discretionary bonus for each financial year, which is payable at the Board’s discretion and determined with reference to the Group’s results and performance for the financial year concerned. The remuneration payable to Mr. Wu was determined by the remuneration committee of the Board having regard to his duties and responsibilities within the Group, the Group’s remuneration policy and the prevailing market condition.

Save as disclosed above, as at the Latest Practicable Date, (i) Mr. Wu did not have, and was not deemed to have, any interests or short position in any Shares, underlying shares or debentures of the Company and its associated corporations within the meaning of Part XV of SFO; (ii) Mr. Wu did not have any relationship with other Directors, senior management, substantial Shareholders or controlling Shareholders (within the meaning of the GEM Listing Rules); and (iii) Mr. Wu did not hold any other directorship in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years or any other position with the Company and other members of the Group or other major appointments and professional qualifications.

Mr. Lau has more than 20 years of experience spanning hedge fund, private equity and investment banking in Asia. He is the co-founder and currently a partner of Ark Pacific Capital Management, a multi-strategy alternative asset manager focusing in Greater China. He was investment director of Elliott Advisors (HK) Ltd (“Elliott”), the Asian arm of Elliott Associates, a global multi-strategy hedge fund. During his tenure at Elliott, he was responsible for investments across asset classes including publicly-listed securities, private equity, structured credit, real estate and fund-of-funds investments in China, Hong Kong and South East Asia. Prior to this, he worked as an investment banker at Citigroup in the Technology, Media & Telecom team running a wide range of mergers and acquisitions and corporate finance transactions. He began his career at JPMorgan’s investment banking division in Hong Kong. Mr. Lau is also a member of the Beijing Municipal Committee of the Chinese People’s Political Consultative Conference.

Mr. Lau has entered into a letter of appointment with the Company for a term of one year, subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at annual general meetings pursuant to the Articles of Association. Mr. Lau is entitled to a monthly director’s fee of HK\$10,000 which was determined by the remuneration committee of the Company with reference to his duties and responsibilities within the Group, the Group’s remuneration policy and the prevailing market condition. He is also entitled to a discretionary bonus for each financial year, which is payable at the Board’s discretion and determined with reference to the Groups’ results and performance for the financial year concerned.

Save as disclosed above, as at the Latest Practicable Date, (i) Mr. Lau did not have and was not deemed to have, any interests or short position in any Shares, underlying shares or debentures of the Company and its associated corporations within the meaning of Part XV of SFO; (ii) Mr. Lau did not have any relationship with other Directors, senior management, substantial Shareholders or controlling Shareholders (within the meaning of the GEM Listing Rules); and (iii) Mr. Lau did not hold any other directorship in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years or any other position with the Company and other members of the Group or other major appointments and professional qualifications.
